1967

The trained shipbuilding engineer Harald Striewski founds his company at the age of 30. Harald Striewski builds the first caravans before the Hobby caravan factory in Fockbek is even founded. He sells two of them immediately and uses the third to go travelling with his family.



1968

The young company grows and moves to a new location. Four members of staff are now employed at the new company premises covering 10,855 square metres on Schafredder in Fockbek.



1970

Hobby had already achieved its original aim of building one caravan per day in 1969. One year later, 42 employees produce six caravans each day.



2006

Hobby has a new address: Harald-Striewski-Straße. Fockbek honours the successful entrepreneur for his services to the community.



2007

German Chancellor Angela Merkel and the Minister President of Schleswig-Holstein Peter Harry Carstensen pay a visit to Hobby in Fockbek.



2009

The half a million mark is reached: in Fockbek, the 500,000th Hobby caravan rolls off the production line – an Excellent 495 UL.

1972

With an expanding model range, the numbers are also rising: 5,000 caravans have now rolled off the production line in Fockbek, made by 132 employees.



1983

Hobby is the caravan market leader in Germany and also becomes the number one throughout Europe one year later. A caravan rolls off the production line every nine minutes in Fockbek.



1984

The Hobby 600 is the brand's first motorhome and also marks the start of an unparalleled success story: the semi-integrated wins the title of "Motorhome of the Year" fifteen times!



1996

Hobby introduces the "All-inclusive package" for all caravan model ranges, setting new industry-wide standards in the process: all models feature top-quality extras when they leave the factory.



1998

Hobby acquires the caravan and motorhome division of Xaver Fendt GmbH & Co. in Asbach-Bäumenheim (Bavaria). It is operated as a wholly-owned Hobby subsidiary under the name Fendt Caravan GmbH.



2011

Hobby redefines the luxury class for caravans: the elegant models in the Premium model range become the benchmark in the luxury segment and have changed the design language of the entire caravanning industry more than any other.



2014

The Vantana van celebrates its launch and wins the European Innovation Award three years later with its unique SlimLine refrigerator.



2016

Launch of the "HobbyComplete" ALL-INCLUSIVE package for the Optima and Siesta: Hobby supplies fully equipped motorhomes that come ready to hit the road – without any supplementary packs or hidden costs.



2017

Motorhoming summit: On her second visit to the Hobby caravan factory, German Chancellor Angela Merkel congratulated Hobby boss Harald Striewski on the company's 50th anniversary.



2017

Hobby celebrates its 50th anniversary with the ultimate street party and a spectacular laser show. The event with 40,000 guests is a gift from company founder Harald Striewski to all Hobby employees and their families.

Rear-ventilated lockers with plenty of storage space and soft-close mechanism

The air vents in the wall units ensure optimal circulation of the rising warmth from the heater. The large gap between the winter vents and the exterior wall prevents damp spots and mildew. The soft-closing doors open up wide towards the ceiling, leaving plenty of headroom. Extra-sturdy hinges ensure a strong opening and locking force.



TV unit with glass cabinet

The TV unit in the entrance area features a stylish glass cabinet with LED ambient lighting.



Handy shelf

The shelf above the entrance door is both decorative and handy. It's a perfect place for storing various items you need every day, so that they're always within easy reach.

150-litre compact Super Slim Tower refrigerator

The 38 cm slimline absorption refrigerator developed by Hobby runs silently and has more capacity and power while taking up less space. Thanks to the Super Slim Tower design, the refrigerator door no longer protrudes as far into the room and the contents are kept even more securely in place.



Seven height-adjustable compartments in the door mean you can now store taller 1.5-litre bottles as well as 1-litre bottles and Tetra Paks. The large 15-litre freezer compartment is removable.

Practical hob/sink combination with more work surface

The gas hob and sink are made from robust stainless steel and form a continuous unit for easier cleaning. The generous space between the three burners makes cooking a lot easier too, even with bigger pans. The hob comes with electric ignition, and the split safety glass cover can be used to provide additional workspace if required.



Practical cutlery insert

Cutlery drawer with well-planned dividers ensures that cutlery and kitchen utensils will not get mixed up even during the journey.



Kitchen drawer in a comfortable size with push lock and soft-close.

The extra-large drawers provide space for all kinds of utensils, and can be fully extended for a good overview and easy access. The soft-close mechanism ensures smooth, quiet closure, with secure locking thanks to the push lock system. Reinforced support struts and longer strike plates keep fully loaded drawers firmly in place even while on the move. (Where an oven is fitted the drawers will be smaller than shown)

Elegant kitchen counter

The modern counter gives the kitchen a very sophisticated look. Its transparent panel with the distinctive Hobby logo is a real design highlight. The counter with its handy shelf also functions as an elegant partition between the seating and kitchen areas.



Kitchen blind with built-in power sockets

The combi-cassette with blackout blind and insect screen has a bright LED kitchen light and two handy placed sockets. (depending on model)



Multifunctional kitchen splashback

The kitchen splashback with the large window and the combi-cassette featuring a fully integrated blackout blind and pleated insect screen is a beautiful, all-in-one unit. A USB charger socket and 230 V power sockets are also perfectly integrated into the kitchen splashback. (depending on model)



Roomy corner floor cupboard

The large pivoting pull-out on the kitchen floor cupboard holds pots and pans, thus making optimal use of the storage space in the kitchen. (depending on model)



Pull out drawer with storage baskets

The pull out drawer with storage baskets can be pulled all the way out allowing full use of the space. (depending on model)



Hand towel rail

In many kitchens, a pull-out towel rail provides a space for tea towels. (depending on model)



Spice rack

Depending on the model, the kitchen wall units come with handy spice racks so you can keep salt, pepper and herbs to hand.

The De Luxe 515 UHK features a total of seven berths. After converting the seating area and letting down the drop-down bed, two comfortable double beds are available in the rear. Three further berths are located in the children's compartment.



Variable drop-down bed

If only the drop-down bed is used, the seating area underneath remains intact. Thanks to the robust cable pull mechanism, the drop-down bed can be lowered into any position and fixed in place beneath the roof together with all of its accoutrements.




Spacious children's room

In addition to the fixed bunk bed with two berths, an additional place to sleep is created in the De Luxe 515 UHK by converting the side seating area.

Child-friendly teddy-bear light

Turn the nose on the bear to dim the light – perfect for sending little campers off to sleep. (depending on model)



Comfortable sprung mattress

All fixed beds are equipped with sprung mattresses and stable laminated beech bed frames.

Bunk beds with colouring board

During the day, the bottom bunk bed can be folded up. This creates a space to play in – with the bottom side of the bed acting as a wipeable board.



For a safe night's sleep, the top bed is fitted with a sturdy rail to prevent you from falling out.

Comfy headboard

The upholstered panel made of easy-to-clean artificial leather at the head of the bed ensures a clean finish, the LED gooseneck lamps give you a pinpoint reading light, and the wide shelves provide you with plenty of space to store books, glasses, clocks and many other personal items.



Easy-action bed lift

Many of the bed frames are fitted with opening aids. This takes the form of a gas spring (Lift-O-Mat) in Queen-size and double beds and a spring mechanism in single beds.

Beautifully shaped front window with practical details

More light, more air, more practical use. The front window has a fully-integrated combi cassette pleated blind with black-out and flyscreen and is complemented by shelves for books and other utensils. (depending on model)



Central light switch and power sockets in sleeping area

An additional light switch in the sleeping area is easy to reach. A power socket in the sleeping area offers additional comfort. (depending on model)

Bright exterior LED lighting

The third brake lamp on the rear awning bar can be seen from far away. Two rear fog lamps and reversing lights are harmoniously integrated in the rear lights and provide additional safety.



The bright LED awning light illuminates the doorway and provides pleasant light in the awning.

One-key closing system

One key for everything: entrance door, gas cylinder locker, storage space lids, boot lid and lid for removing WC cassette.



Overrun brake by KNOTT with automatic adjustment

The KNOTT ANS overrun brake adjusts itself automatically, guaranteeing unrestricted braking performance at all times. A key safety feature, particularly in critical driving conditions.

Nose wheel with load indicator

The safety nose wheel with integrated load scales is included as standard on many models. (depending on model)



WINTERHOFF stabiliser hitch

Easy coupling – safe arrival: the WINTERHOFF WS 3000 safety coupling with tracking stabiliser and unrivalled single-lever system is included with Hobby.

Beautifully shaped entrance door handle

In virtually all Hobby caravans, owners and their guests are greeted by an ergonomically shaped grab handle that's a real eye-catcher with its gleaming chrome and exclusive Hobby logo. (depending on model)



A-Frame with walk-on cover

The A-Frame is perfectly matched to the respective chassis, which helps with handling on the road. The A-Frame cover is moulded to fit perfectly and give a clean look to the front of the caravan.

Extra-wide entrance door with window, triple-point locking, concealed hinges, storage shelves and waste bin

The extra-wide, one-piece entrance door with concealed inside hinges impresses not just with its generous dimensions but also its appealing design and thoughtful details. The large integrated window lets plenty of light into the caravan interior and forms an elegant unit with the frame.



The inside of the door is equipped with handy shelves, a waste bin and a pleated insect screen. The practical waste bin with integrated dustpan and brush helps you to keep the caravan clean. Another notable feature of the Hobby door, which is 40 mm wider than standard doors, is the highly effective splash water seal.

High-quality vent windows

The tinted outside windows are made as part of a casting process. In combination with a higher material thickness, this makes them considerably more resistant against tension and deformities (particularly in cold and hot environments). Another positive effect is the improved sound insulation. A new sealing system also provides long-lasting protection against humidity.



Wheel trims and tyre pressure display

The standard wheel trims in white are optimally designed to match your caravan. The correct tyre pressure is indicated on the wheel arch guard. An integrated rubber clamping lip provides a visually elegant wheel covering solution. (draught skirt not included)

Front end construction

The well-planned front end design is dominated by a solid corner construction made from a moulded PU frame. The sandwich construction with EPS core and the stable windowsill made from PE foam above the gas cylinder locker ensure the highest levels of insulation. PU-foamed corner posts serve as a strong front - sidewall connection, are water-resistant and also have good insulation characteristics. They provide a permanent way of connecting the ABS moulded parts and give rise to the unique exterior design of Hobby caravans with their beautiful rounded edges. (Ontour, De Luxe, De Luxe Edition, Excellent, Prestige)




Gleaming rear brace

The chrome-coloured rear brace positioned right above the number plate on the De Luxe Edition, Excellent and Prestige is a real eye-catching feature.



The inside light in the wardrobe is automatically switched on when the door is opened and provides bright light for an optimal overview.



Light control system with basic operating panel

The light control system with CI-BUS technology is located in the entrance area of all Hobby caravans. It controls nearly all the lighting units, shows the fresh water level and regulates the hot water heating unit and the optionally available underfloor heating. (depending on model)



Touch-control light switches

The separate light switches feature a touch-control mechanism. This makes them easier to operate.



Children's light switches

Can be easily reached by little campers: the light switch is at a child-friendly height.

TRUMA water heater

The tried-and-tested TRUMA water heater with a 5-litre capacity uses the warmth from the heater to heat the water. An electric heating element also heats the water, however, when the heating is not turned on.



TRUMA combination hot air heating system with hot water boiler

The hot air pipes of the TRUMA combi heater ensure an optimal distribution of heated air throughout the vehicle for a cosy temperature. It is controlled via the Hobby TFT control panel and also via the digital CP PLUS TRUMA control panel in the sleeping area.

The gas distributor is easily accessible in the kitchen.

The powerful fan with booster function on the serially fitted TRUMA heater ensures quick heat in the caravan in an effective and environmentally friendly manner.



Central on-board technology installation

The on-board technology systems – comprising heating, power supply with transformer and ground fault circuit breaker, two power sockets and antenna connection – are readily accessible inside the spacious wardrobe. (example)



Water and electricity connections

A standard outdoor socket is provided for connecting the caravan to the power supply. The awning socket with SAT/TV connection allows you to connect 230 volt devices (optional in the Ontour, De Luxe and De Luxe Edition). The water connection lets you fill the water tank easily with a hose. All outside connectors have pictograms to make their functions clear.





Hobby CI-BUS on-board management system with TFT control panel

Whether TRUMA, ALDE or DOMETIC: thanks to the cross-sector interface, the new symbols and graphics on the Hobby TFT operating panel depict a cross-section of all manufacturers' symbols, meaning that users will find themselves in a familiar environment as far as icons are concerned. Displays such as date / time, inside / outside temperature, water tank level and battery charge / discharge can be read on the display panel or settings can be activated directly. Other BUS-capable on-board components, such as heating, air conditioning and electric sunroof, can be centrally controlled. The system is standardised, can be updated and is therefore compatible with future appliance generations. Up to 15 appliances can already communicate with the control panel. (Observe manufacturer's instructions; in Premium and Landhaus ranges. All caravans supplied through our official dealer scheme will have our flag on the Tft panel. This shows they are compliant to UK specifications. Notice: safety requirements differ from country to country.)



12-Volt autonomous package and latest battery management

The intelligent battery sensor IBS supplies all the important data such as charging time, charging current and charging voltage, as well as the remaining running time and discharge current of the GEL or AGM battery in autonomous mode. All values can be read on the TFT operating panel. The battery sensors supply the intelligent charger with the exact charging current and voltage it needs, thereby ensuring battery-conserving charging until it is 100% full. Charging times are reduced by approx. 30% with this system compared to standard chargers.

HobbyConnect

Developed exclusively for Hobby leisure vehicles, the HobbyConnect M2M system allows you to control the entire on-board technology via mobile devices such as smartphones or tablets. For this you will need the "MyHobby" app, which can be used to check or directly activate settings such as time, temperatures, filling levels and battery charge.



Other BUS-capable on-board components such as heating and air conditioning can also be centrally controlled, with HobbyConnect providing an interface between the caravan's CI-BUS on-board management system and the Internet. That means you can connect directly with virtually any location in the world from your own vehicle. Data communication takes place in both directions via a special web server. That way you can receive push notifications on the mobile device, e.g. if the vehicle is removed from its location in case of theft.

ALDE hot-water heater

The ALDE hot water heater 3020 HE with a total power output of 8,500 watts and an integrated 8.4-litre boiler is available from type 490. Heating and water heating can be activated both simultaneously and independently of one another.



All caravans up to type 495 (standard on 460 Sff) can be fitted with the TRUMA VarioHeat "Comfort". It features three heat settings, warms up the caravan in next to no time, and automatically adjusts the heat output to the required room temperature. As a digital gas heating system, it can be perfectly integrated into the Hobby CI-BUS on-board management system.


Underfloor heating

All Hobby caravans can be supplied with an electric underfloor heating system. The heating foils in the walking area of the floor prevent thermal bridges and cold feet.



Hot water underfloor heating

The combination of a hot water heater and hot water underfloor heating provides the highest levels of comfort. The floor is warmed up by a system of pipes, through which the hot water flows. In conjunction with heat transfer panels, the heat is distributed throughout the floor of the vehicle.



Additional electric heating

The additional electric heating TRUMA Ultraheat supports the TRUMA gas heating and uses the existing hot air pipes. It ensures quicker heat on cold days.



DOMETIC roof-mounted air-conditioning system FreshJet with heating function

The roof-mounted air conditioning unit has four controllable air flow settings. This quality lightweight system is economical and pleasantly quiet.



Satellite system

The fully automatic satellite system Cap 650 from Kathrein includes a rotating flat antenna with a large range. Measuring just 21 centimetres high, it has excellent aerodynamic qualities. The antenna comes with a twin LNB, which means that two receivers can be integrated in the system and are automatically aligned.



TRUMA electric boiler, 14 litres

The optionally available efficient heating element heats the water from 15° C to 70° C in just 70 minutes. The long heat storage ensures extremely short reheating times and this saves energy and money.



USB charging socket

This optional double socket can charge two mobile devices at the same time. The LED reading lights for the children's beds are also each equipped with an integrated USB charging socket.



TV jointed bracket with pivot arm

Optionally available for many models: the swivelling TV bracket for watching TV from the seating area or bed – top-rated by the German specialist magazine "Camping, Cars & Caravans". A pull-out shelf for the TV is used in vehicles where there is not enough room to fit the articulated bracket.
